DECISION

The Municipal Veterinary Administration Prague, division the National Veterinary Administration (henceforth only MěVS Prague SVS), being the administrative authority of competence under Section 47(4) and Section 49(1h/7) of Act No. 166/1999 Coll., on veterinary care, amending certain contingent laws (the Veterinary Act), as amended (henceforth only the Veterinary Act), and under Section 67 of Act No. 500/2004 Coll., the Administrative Code, as amended (henceforth only the Administrative Code) **rules** as follows:

Attestation and Registration is hereby granted to:

ALS Czech Republic, s.r.o., IČ 27407551, a limited liability company based at Na Harfě 336/9, 190 00 Prague 9 - Vysočany (henceforth only ALS CR, s.r.o.) pursuant to Sec. 49(1h/7) of the Veterinary Act, and to the company's laboratories for testing food, fodder, and medicaments (Laboratoře testování potravin, krmiv a léčiv), located on the 4th and 5th floor of ALS CR, s.r.o., at Na Harfě 336/9, 190 00 Prague 9 - Vysočany (henceforth only Laboratories on 4th & 5th floor) for the following activities:

1. Import, storage, and use for laboratory analysis of food and fodder samples of animal origin for the purposes of ascertaining their health safety

under Attestation No. CZ 11712990

Justification

On March 7, 2012, MěVS Prague SVS received a requisition from ALS Czech Republic, s.r.o., for the Attestation and registration of its laboratories for testing food, fodder, and medicaments, located on the 4th and 5th floor of the company's domicile for importing, storing, and using food and fodder samples of animal origin for ascertaining their health safety.

The administrative authority has considered the request and executed official inspections of the facilities, on March 7, 2012, and March 13, 2012, in order to be able to approve them, i.e., Laboratories for Testing Food, Fodder, and Medicaments on the 4th and 5th Floor of the company's domicile, with the aim to verify whether the provisions and furnishings of the laboratories satisfy the requirements of EU Council Directive No. 1069/2009 (EC), and declares that the submitted documentation is adequate, the request legitimate, and laboratories' practical provisions comply with the relevant provisions of the Veterinary Act and the regulations of the European Parliament and Council.

This Attestation and Registration is subject to the following conditions:

- a) it is prohibited to use samples of animal origin for any other purposes;
- b) the applicant is obliged to ensure that unused samples of animal origin shall be disposed of in a safe manner or shipped back to the place of their origin.

The issuing authority, MěVS Prague SVS, reserves the right to withdraw or suspend this Attestation and Registration, or even cancel it, as applicable, if the conditions stipulated in the Veterinary Act or European Union's Directive concerning the aforesaid activities are not fulfilled.

Instructions

This Decision may be appealed at the Central Veterinary Administration of SVS through MěVS Prague SVS within 15 days following the delivery hereof.
